- Experience collecting water samples and performing environmental monitoring.
- Experience with SCADA systems (e.g. RSLogix, IFix, etc.).
- Journeyman Electrician or Instrumentation Certificate is a huge asset.

- Well-developed analytical, evaluative and problem solving skills.
- Strong interpersonal communication and writing skills.
- Valid and clean class G driver's licence.

#### **Duties will include:**

- Operating the Lime Treatment Plant (LTP) to maintain Acid Collection Pond (ACP) water levels within operating parameters and final effluent quality within allowable discharge limits, as prescribed by the site Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA).
- LTP inspections and maintenance for mechanical, instrumentation and electrical systems are performed as required and that the required critical spares are available.
- Snow plowing as required to maintain site access to all required access points.
- LTP equipment repairs or replacement as necessary, when safe to do so.
- Adherence to the DES safety culture at all times
- Monthly Health and Safety inspections.
- Collection of surface, groundwater samples and other field data according to an established schedule based on regulatory and internal requirements.
- Ensure collected samples are prepared, sealed and delivered as required.
- Ensure the integrity of the SCADA system through operation, monitoring and maintenance as required.
- Ensure lime and other reagent requirements for the LTP are met and that coordination and good communications amongst the Supplier, truck driver and Project Manager are maintained.
- Provide input for monthly and annual reports regarding LTP and pumping station activities.
- Assist and input with maintenance and review of Operating Manuals and Procedures.
- Report any public complaints, concerns, incidents, accidents or near misses in a timely fashion as required by DES and client.
- Provide site orientation, direction and oversight to ensure all visitors and/or contract workers adhere to safety conformance while attending &/or working on site.
- On-call to respond to site alarm conditions
