ETPO/Environmental Technician - Full time position - Elliot Lake

DES is seeking to fill a full time Effluent Treatment Plant Operator (ETPO)/Environmental Technician position based out of our Elliot Lake office. The Ideal Candidate will possess:

- Background in Environmental and/or Treatment Plant Operation.
- Experience in surface and ground water sampling.
- Knowledge of environmental approvals and permitting processes.
- Knowledge and experience in the operation of snowmobiles, boats, motors, and ATVs.
- Well-developed analytical, evaluative and problem solving skills.
- Strong interpersonal communication and writing skills are required.
- Valid class G driver's licence.

PRIMARY ROLE:

The ETP Operator (ETPO) Environmental Field Technician is responsible for collecting air, surface and ground water samples in accordance with written procedures. The ETPO is responsible for completing Health & Safety and facility inspections, operating effluent treatment plants and pump stations, sample preparation for shipment to external labs, participate in the completion of regulatory reports and verify and importing and posting data in the environmental data base. The position requires a level of fitness, knowledge and experience in the operation of snowmobiles, boats, motors, and ATV's.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **General**
 - Conformance with Health and Safety training requirements defined for this position.
 - Perform Emergency Response Role(s) as assigned by Manager for Client or DES emergencies.
 - Understand and implement DES Quality Management System.
 - Familiarity with conformance with Administrative procedures.
 - Conformance with DMC policies.
- **Position Specific**
 - Collect the required field data and samples throughout the monitoring region according to an established schedule based on regulatory and internal requirements
 - Organization and maintenance of sample bottles, supplies and measuring equipment for field and sample prep room operations
 - Operating DMI and Client Effluent Treatment Plants (ETP) to maintain water levels within operating parameters and final effluent quality within allowable discharge limits, as prescribed

- Initiate purchasing of parts and supplies relating to ETP equipment and operations, following DES purchasing procedures
- Perform some in situ ETP equipment repairs
- Perform various monthly maintenance tasks on ETP equipment
- Ensure lime requirements to the ETP's are met and that coordination and good communications amongst the Supplier, Operations Superintendent and truck driver are maintained.
- Cross train additional staff in the operation of the ETP's and TMA's
- Preparation of samples for shipment to external laboratories in accordance with QA/QC procedures
- Entering/importing data and reviewing in the data Management System
- Complete monthly Health & Safety inspections including radon monitoring when required
- Complete monthly facility inspections
- Perform annual shaft cap inspections
- Monitor dam integrity in relation to beaver activity and vegetation growth
- Perform annual surveys of various berms and spillways to closely monitor elevations
- Scheduled on-call coverage as required
- Assisting Compliance Coordinator with scheduling requirements where deviations occur due to unforeseeable influences
- Assist in the completion of Regulatory and Client reports
- Participates in Client HSEC, FRCP and other audit programs
- Knowledge of responsibilities and participates in client Incident Management Training (IMT)
- Perform radiation scans on equipment prior to release from the sites
- Maintain and review Op Docs as prescribed in the Op Doc Registry.
- Awareness of DES/Client property and reports concerns in a timely fashion
- Reports any public complaints, concerns, incident, accidents and/or near miss in a timely fashion
- Participates in the investigation and development of corrective and preventive actions as required.
